| 1 | 1 | <b>Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne (12%)</b><br>Rich and dry with great depth of flavour from this famous Reims house. Blended from a high proportion of Pinot grapes and aged for a mature, rounded character. | £42.95 |
| 2 | 2 | <b>Prosecco Extra Dry, Fantinel, Italy (11.5%)</b><br>Fresh, dry and fruity. A pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral-based hints. A smooth, velvety and poetic flavour.                            | £17.95 |

| 11 | 4 | <b>Mill Cellars Chardonnay, SE Australia, Australia (13.5%)</b><br>Rich and rounded citrus and tropical fruits seasoned with vanilla spice. | £12.95 |
| 12 | 2 | <b>Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile (13%)</b><br>Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.      | £12.95 |

| 3  | 2 | <b>Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, San Floriano, Italy (11.5%)</b><br>Delicate flavours of apples and pears on a refreshingly dry palate.  | £13.95 |
| 4  | 2 | <b>Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa (13.5%)</b><br>Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe tropical fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.   | £14.95 |
| 5  | 3 | <b>Brookfield Reserve Chardonnay-Viognier, SE Australia, Australia (13.5%)</b><br>Peach and apricot notes combine with tropical fruit in this softly textured wine.  | £15.95 |
| 6  | 2 | <b>Blackstone Chardonnay, Monterey County, USA (14%)</b><br>Crisp, lively acidity, delicious tropical fruit flavours, great depth and richness, a delicate touch of tasty oak on the finish.   | £17.95 |
| 7  | 2 | <b>Wynns Riesling, Coonawarra, Australia (12%)</b><br>A delicious, floral palate and a refreshing, lime flavour on the finish, an intriguing and classically fruity Riesling. A typical Australian example of this wholly under-rated grape variety. | £19.95 |
| 8  | 1 | <b>Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils, France (12.5%)</b><br>Made in classic Chablis style, it is lean and elegant with underlying Chardonnay fruit from the northern tip of Burgundy.   | £19.95 |
| 9  | 1 | <b>Vidal Estate Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (14.5%)</b><br>Classically crisp and herbaceously intense with great complexity, a mingling of passion fruit and melon flavours  | £22.95 |
| 10 | 1 | <b>Sancerre La Fuzelle, Adrien Maréchal, France (12.5%)</b><br>Distinctively elegant. Laden with racy crispness and abundant gooseberry crunch.  | £24.95 |

## Rosé

- 13 4 **Mill Cellars Rosé, SE Australia, Australia (12%)** £12.95  
Ripe raspberry fruit lifted by a touch of sweetness on the finish.

## House Reds

- 22 C **Mill Cellars Shiraz, SE Australia, Australia (14.5%)** £12.95  
Forest fruits such as blackberries dominate the fruit-packed palate.
- 23 C **Tierra Merlot, Maule Valley, Chile (13%)** £12.95  
Ripe blackberry aromas and a subtle underlay of oak with bright, ripe berry flavours and smooth tannins.

## Reds

- 14 B **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Collezione Marchesini, Italy (11%)** £13.95  
Grown on the eastern Adriatic coastline giving an intensity of colour and heady bouquet of violets and oranges.
- 15 C **Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia, Australia (13.5%)** £14.95  
Medium-bodied and fruity with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices.
- 16 C **Casa La Joya Cabernet Sauvignon, Colchagua Valley, Chile (13%)** £15.95  
The balance of rich berry flavours and a soft minted finish perfected by this family-owned winery.
- 17 C **Penfolds Private Release Shiraz-Cabernet Sauvignon, SE Australia, Australia (13%)** £16.95  
Bright, deep purple red colour with spicy sweet blackberry lift, with a background of cherry and dusty oak. Medium-bodied with balanced tannins, the fruit flavours are dominated by blackberry and rhubarb.
- 18 C **Marques de Morano Rioja Crianza Tinto, Spain (13%)** £17.95  
Mazuelo adds a ripe cherry chunkiness to the smooth raspberries and cream style of Tempranillo.
- 19 C **Château Moulin du Barrail, Bordeaux Supérieur, France (13.5%)** £19.95  
Intense black cherry aromas sumptuously encase generous layers of vanilla oak cream, powerful and well balanced.
- 20 B **Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin, France (13%)** £22.95  
The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 21 C **Drylands Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand (13.5%)** £27.50  
Lifted cherry and plum flavours layered with an attractive earthy, gamey character and a smooth, lingering finish.

## WINE TASTE GUIDE

White Wines are rated from 1-9. Number 1 being the driest and 9 being the sweetest.

Red Wines are rated from A-E. A being the lightest and E being the most full-bodied.
